Know all men by these presents that the undersigned, Helen L. Geansslen, being the sole owner of the land shown on this plat, does hereby certify that the foregoing plat designated as GAENSSLEN SUBDIVISION is located in Lot 8 and the SW1/4 DE1/4, Section 36, T9N, R20W, SW1/4, Sweetwater County, Wyoming, and is particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the one-quarter corner common to said Section 36 and Section 1, T9N, R20W, monumented by a D.M. brass cap on 2" iron pipe, thence S 89° 30' 00" E, 182.90 feet along the south line of said Section 36 to the Point of Beginning monumented by a Nelson Engineering, PE 2 L.S. 978, brass cap on 2" iron pipe, thence N 00° 10' 00" E, 905.70 feet to a Nelson Engineering, PE 2 L.S. 978, brass cap on 2" iron pipe, thence S 04° 20' 00" E, 100.00 feet parallel with the south line of said Section 36 to a Nelson Engineering, PE 2 L.S. 978, brass cap on 2" iron pipe, thence N 10° 21' 50" E, 200.00 feet to a Nelson Engineering, PE 2 L.S. 978, brass cap on 2" iron pipe, thence S 91° 02' 50" E, 793.44 feet to a Nelson Engineering, PE 2 L.S. 978, brass cap on 2" iron pipe, thence S 15° 57' 18" E, brass cap on 2" iron pipe, thence a horizontal circular curve commencing at a point on a horizontal radius of 450.00 feet, a central angle of 11° 23' 15", and a chord radius of 450.00 feet, a central angle of 11° 23' 15", and a chord radius of 450.00 feet, to a Nelson Engineering, which bears S 82° 44' 07" E, 89.29 feet, to a Nelson Engineering, PE 2 L.S. 978, brass cap on 2" iron pipe, thence S 02° 27' 49" E, 159.97 feet to a Nelson Engineering, PE 2 L.S. 978, brass cap on 2" iron pipe, thence N 89° 30' 00" W, 182.90 feet along the south line of said Section 36 to the first 1/16 corner monumented by a R.L.S. 164 brass cap on 2" iron pipe, thence N 89° 30' 00" W, 479.00 feet continuing along said south line to the Point of Beginning, the Back Bearing being N 89° 30' 00" W along the south line of the SW1/4 DE1/4 of said Section 36, and contains an area of 15.80 acres, more or less, and that this subdivision, as it is described and as it appears on this plat, is made with the free consent and in accordance with the desires of the undersigned owner and proprietor, and that this is a correct plat of the area as it is divided into lots, blocks, streets, and utility easements, and that the undersigned owner of the land shown and described on this plat does hereby dedicate to the public use all streets, alleys, easements, and other lands within the boundary lines of the plat as indicated and not already otherwise dedicated for public use.

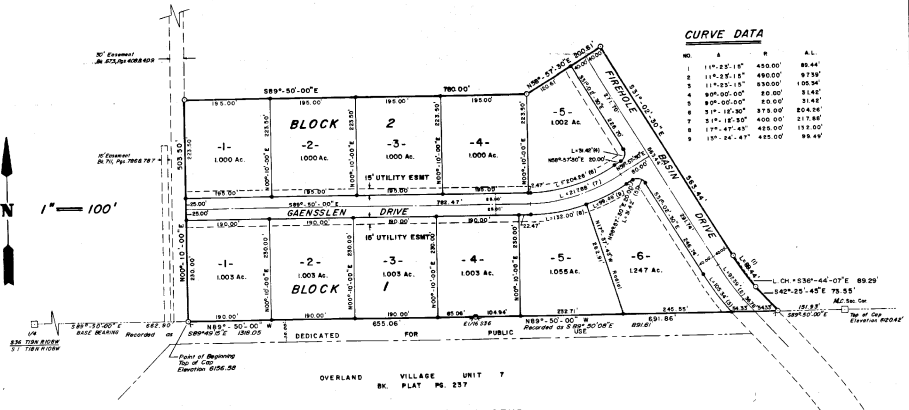

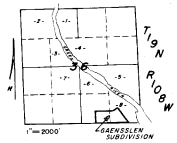
