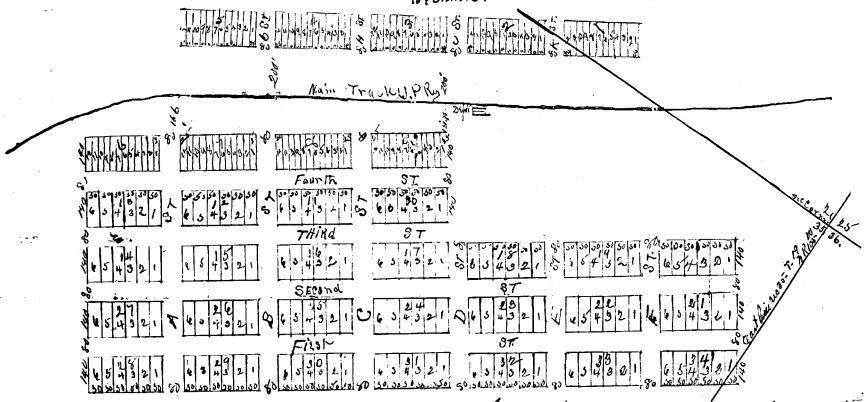

The Union Pacific Railway as aforesaid being the original owner and proprietor of the lands shown on this plat and being subdivided and sold from a town named Rock Springs, we hereby cause the same to be surveyed and staked into lots, blocks and streets, and a plat thereof to be made with reference to known monuments, according to the subdivision and divisions of said tract, reserving the same by progressive numbers, and giving the dimensions and length and breadth thereof and the breadth of the streets thereon, do hereby state and make known that the said subdivision of the above described tract as appears on the accompanying plat is with the free consent of the said public use.
