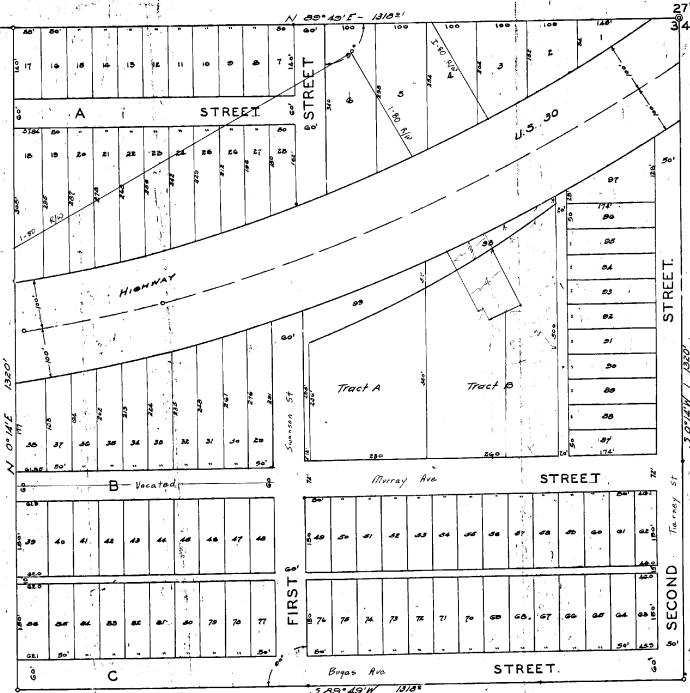


--- DIST TO NW COR of Section
