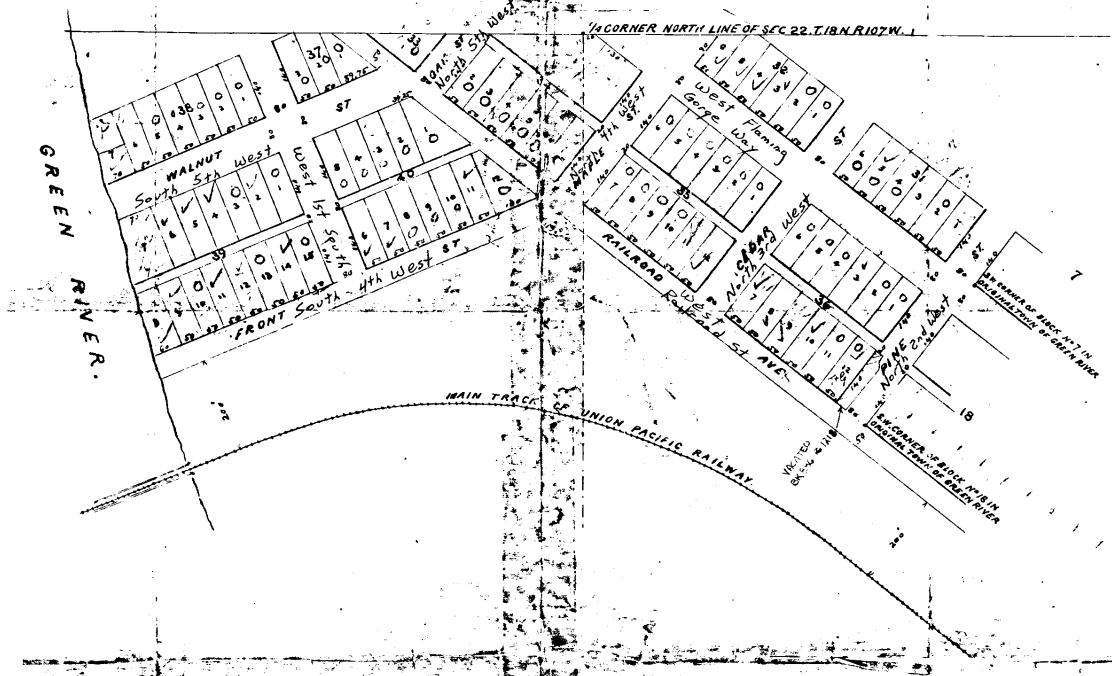


MAP
